## 2020-2021 Haverford Cost Sheet First Year Students Living at Home

For purposes of determining your financial aid, we have used the following amounts to represent the cost of attending Haverford College during the 2020-2021 academic year as a student living with parents or family. Although we believe these costs to be accurate, the College does reserve the right to adjust these as necessary. Should such adjustments happen, you will receive an updated Financial Aid Decision.

**Student health insurance** is a separate charge that cannot be covered by financial aid. All students are required to have personal health insurance, and will be charged for this by Haverford. Students who can prove they are actively covered may have this charge waived. During the 2020-2021 academic year, student health insurance cost \$1,782. **Tax information regarding grants and scholarships.** Many students are surprised to learn that a portion of their grants may be taxed by the IRS. ### MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN

Families who prefer to pay tuition and fees in monthly installments may do so through a plan provided by our eBill partner, Nelnet. Students must access Nelnet on-line to establish a plan. Directions for access can be found on the Student Accounts page of the Haverford website under “Haverford College Payment Plan.” Students may also grant access to parents or other authorized parties so that they can establish plans directly, view tuition charges, and print bill statements for personal or tax purposes.
